One Chinese student was invited by fellow Chinese students with these words, "They have food, you should come."

She came to our Investigative Bible Meeting specifically for students that are new to the Christianity. She got saved, baptized in the Holy Spirit, and baptized in

water. Upon her return to her country, we had a video conversation with her via wechat. During this conversation she observed, "Everyone here [in China] just...focuses on their career. No one is concerned about the state of their soul. They need Jesus."
