Thomas and Mary (husband and wife) are from Finland, and are both children of missionaries. Thomas studied music at UMSL. Mary grew up in

Japan, where her parents were missionaries, and speaks Japanese fluently. Here is a message we recently received from Mary:

> I want to thank you that when we were in USA you encouraged me so many times in many different ways Back then I didn't have much confidence in my musical career and kind of had stopped making music. Now that God has opened the doors again and I've said to Him to be willing to share gospel through music (especially to Japan) many amazing things has started... Now that I understand a little bit more, <u>that it is all about Jesus</u>, He is there with me so I don't have to sing or play alone. He can send His amazing love through music!!

> I'm going to Japan in May for 15 days as a cellist in one band called "mikko goes to heaven". We are going to have 21 concerts there and reaching out about 2000 people or so...

> Then on June me and Thomas are going to **Kosovo** for youth art camp, I'm teaching accapella choir there. It is going to be very exciting for about half of the students are Muslims. All the teachers and leaders are Christians.

So please pray for these two tasks that God would give His wisdom and power and heavenly melodies that will touch peoples hearts and lead them to Jesus, amen

Who would have thought that this couple we met and encouraged would go on to share the gospel in Finland, Japan and Kosovo? And who knows what God has in store for them?
